enrolling children in new schools

At the beginning of the year, all children were enrolled into new schools within their communities. Kivuli has ensured provision of essential school requirements needed for the smooth learning of the children including school fees, stationery and school uniforms.

ccis training

The social work team has been passionate about training other CCI's (Charitable Children Institutions) on the home based care program. A number of social workers from these institutions have benefited from this training. The goal of these training sessions is to encourage other institutions to take up home based care as an alternative to institutionalised care, and to highlight the importance of children growing up in families.



school/home visits

The Kivuli social work team has dedicatedly carried out regular home and school visits. The reports have showed that the children's progress has been great, both at home and in school, with the children feeling more happy and content.



family empowerment

In a bid to achieve sustainability for the children and their families in the long run, Kivuli has empowered these families by starting small income generating projects. Lighting has been a major challenge for many families where these children live. Provision of solar lighting has been a big step in improving the lives of these families and also ensuring that the children are able to study sufficiently.



covid-19 awareness

In light of the global health crisis that the world is facing, Kivuli has not been left behind in ensuring the safety of families during this time. The families have been supported with tanks for running water and food to sustain them as they face significant challenges during this pandemic.
